Hope to see you again in 4 years.

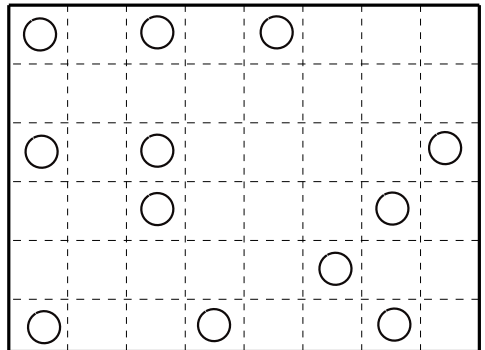
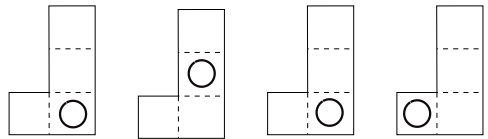
### KNOTS BY STITCH

#### WHERE THE L?

Twelve L-shapes like the ones below have been inserted in the grid. Each has one hole in it. There are three pieces of each of the four kinds shown below and any piece might be rotated or flipped over before being put in the grid. No two pieces of the same kind touch each other, even at a corner. The pieces fit together so well that you cannot see the spaces between the pieces; only the holes show.
